**ORDER OF ACTING MASTER STRK
MADE 29 May 2018**

UPON APPLICATION of the first plaintiff by proposed amended originating process IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Pursuant to Order 21 Rules 5 and 6 of the Rules of the Supreme Court 1971 (WA), leave be granted to the first plaintiff to file an Amended Originating Process in terms of that attached at Annexure "A" to this order.
2. Pursuant to section 439A(6) and 447A(1) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (the Act), the period within which the first plaintiff must convene second meetings of the creditors of Cleveland Mining Company Limited ACN 122 711 880 (Administrators Appointed) and Cleveland Mining Limited ACN 136 441 926 (Administrators Appointed) (the Companies) under section 439A of the Act up to and including 3 August 2018.
3. Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Act, Part 5.3A of the Act is to have effect in relation to the first plaintiff such that the meetings of the creditors of the Companies required by section 439A of the Act may be held at any time during the period up to, or within 5 business days after the end of the convening period as extended by order 1 above, notwithstanding the provisions of section 439A(2) of the Act.
4. Liberty to apply be granted to any person, including any creditor of the Companies or the Australian Securities & Investments Commission, who can demonstrate sufficient interest to modify or discharge these orders upon three business days' written notice being given to the first plaintiff and to this Court.

5. Liberty to apply be granted to the first plaintiff in relation to any further extension of the convening period or any other matter arising in the administrations generally.
6. The first plaintiff's costs and expenses of this application be paid from the assets of the Companies.
7. The first plaintiff's give written notice of this order by:
 - (a) posting a copy to each creditor known to the first plaintiff at the last known address for that creditor; and
 - (b) publishing a copy on the first plaintiff's website www.hallchadwick.com.au - within three business days of this order.
